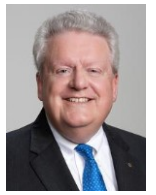

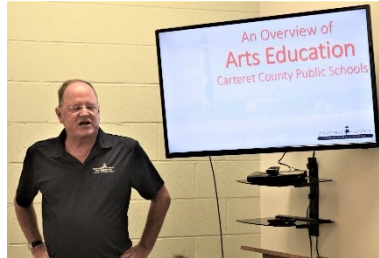

Craig Everett – Music and Art Education in CC

Carteret County Schools have robust and award-winning music and arts programs. Craig Everett, Director, of the county programs gave an excellent over-view of all the activities from grade school through high school.



Music (choral and band) and Art (visual and performing) education begins with 3,500 elementary students and continues at least weekly through high school. Our band programs are a model for schools all over the state, and the bands perform and compete both regionally and nationally. West's HS band will perform in Indianapolis over Thanksgiving this year.

Over 2,000 individual works of student art are displayed at the annual Art from the Heart show, and at area banks, pharmacies and parks where the students consistently win awards.

There are four public choral programs each year, and our students score superior ratings at State Music Assessments. All three high schools present musicals each spring, most recently, "Oklahoma".

Needs for the future include middle school choral teachers (currently not funded), general music and art for Bridges Learning Center and Carteret Preschool, an additional band director for Broad Creek and Newport, and classes in digital music technology and recording and in art photography.

Funding comes from multiple sources: the county, the Board of Education, and the community.



Other special arts enrichment programs are funded by Big Rock and by Carteret County's Arts Council, Arts Forum and Community Theater.

On Saturday, September 21, all three bands will present a "Preview Show" at 7 pm at ECHS.
