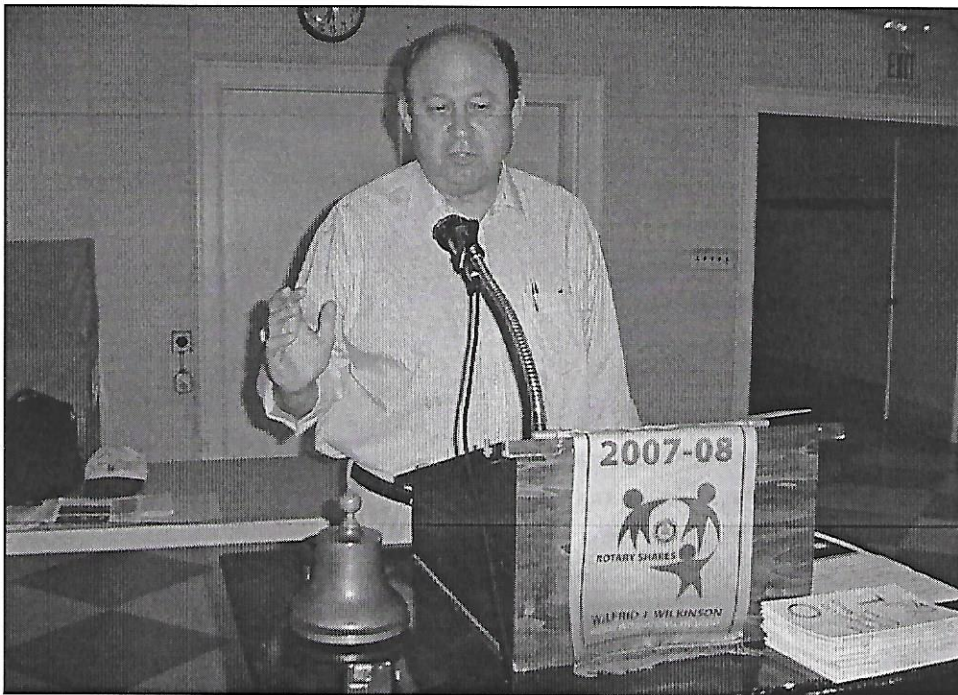

## John Civils Wants to See The Waterfowl Museum Expand

John Civils said fund raising for Core Sound Waterfowl Museum began in May of 1992. Billy Smith was the driving force. The first phase of site development was reached in 1996. This phase consisted of clearing on the property of the Core Sound Waterfowl Museum which began in November of 1997.

Construction on the building began in February 1999 and in November 2000, the exterior was 98% completed (with only back porches and decks incomplete). The second floor framework was completed shortly thereafter, despite hurricanes and floods progress continued.

Since 2000, the Museum has worked on three more important components of the project - the museum's educational programs, development of the exhibit outline and committee and staff resources. These improvements will allow The Core Sound Waterfowl Museum to meet the needs of the new facility.

Research and planning are now in process for exhibitions and long-range

programming. These plans that will give the Waterfowl Museum a working vision to serve the communities of Down East for the future as well as preserving its past.

John has served as a member of the board since its formation in 1992.

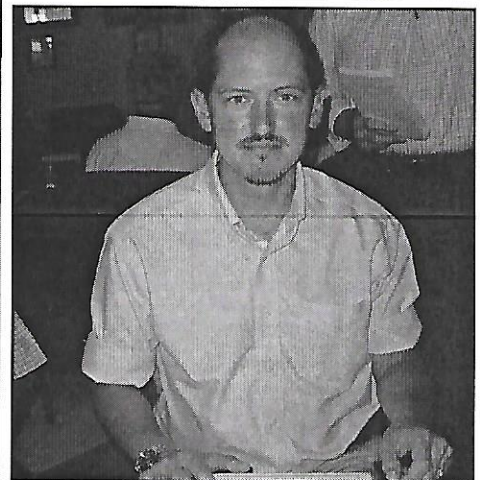

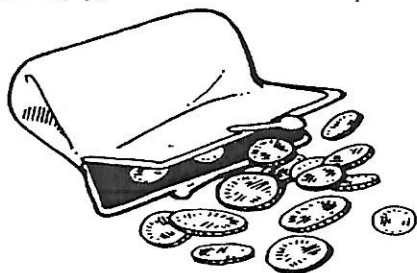

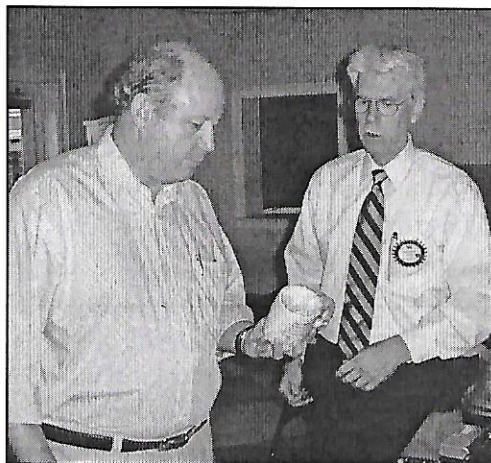
