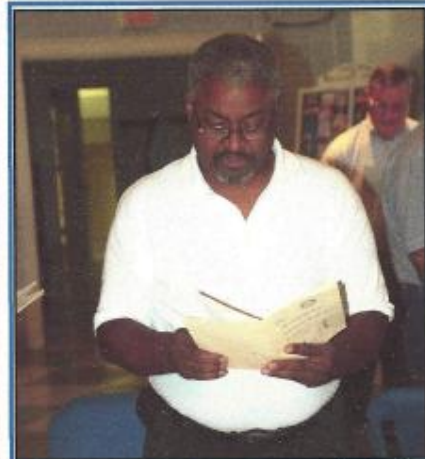
Synchronicity Is Not To Be Scoffed At The Uncanny Does Happen...Often

Tonight's guest speaker is Biologist Gerald Godette, who will present a talk on understanding our environment.



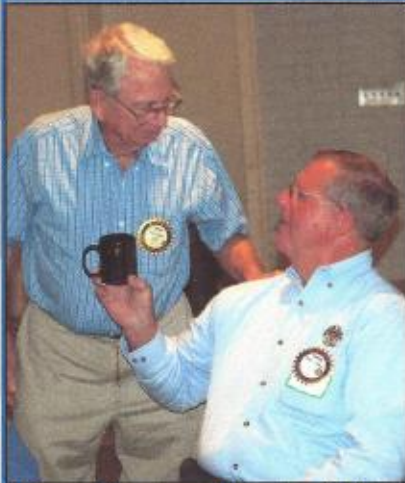

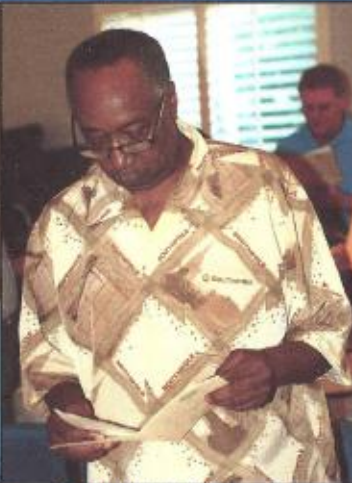
