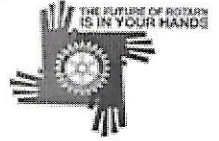

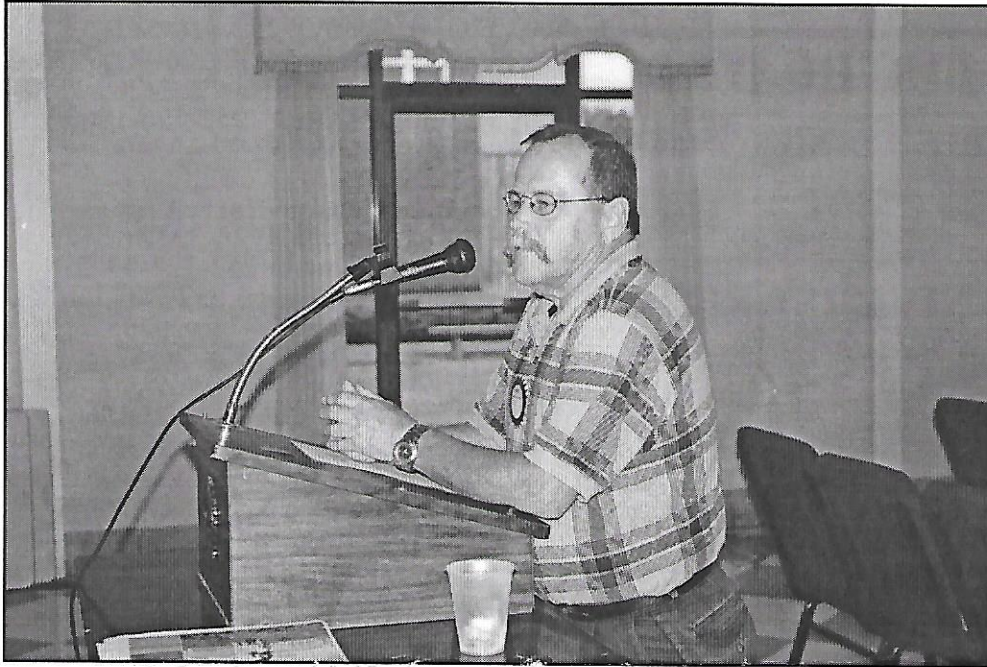

Bill Ward Keeps Rotarians Up-to-Date On Latest Energy Saving Strategies

Herb Phillips had the program last week. His guest speaker was Bill Ward, Public Relations Officer at Carteret-Craven Electric Cooperative.

Bill spoke briefly about new techniques being developed to save energy in businesses and residential homes. Following his talk, he showed a video that

illustrated several money saving technique that homeowners could use to conserve energy...the most cost effective one being the replacement of incandescent bulbs with fluorescent ones. According to the video, the A/C, water heater, and clothes dryer consume the most energy. Control these and you will save on your electric bill.

The 4-Way Test, found below, was created in 1932 by Rotarian Herbert J. Taylor and is one of the most widely quoted statements of business ethics.

1. Is it the TRUTH?
2. Is it FAIR to all concerned?
3. Will it build GOOD WILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?
4. Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?


