

Biologist Gerald Godette

Last week's guest speaker was Biologist Gerald Godette, who is a senior research scientist at Alderson Bioscience Inc. in Beaufort. The company manufactures electrochemical meters that detect mutant genes, bioterrorism agents and poisonous metals.

Gerald's talk centered on understanding our environment. "If we understand our environment, we can better understand ourselves." Gerald said. "By studying the blood of the horseshoe crab and the blue crap we learn more about hemoglobin and its role in the blood of vertebrates. It is a fascinating study.

In addition to being a scientist, Garald is a playwright, singer, song writer and historian.
