Our guest speaker tonight is District Governor Magda Grillo Baggett. Magda is Assistant Dean of Students for Special Programs at Methodist University in Fayetteville, NC. She has a Bachelor's degree in Sociology and a Master's degree in Human Relations, degrees which have served her well during many years as an Army wife and professional in the field of human services. She is from the "DEEP SOUTH" – born in Puerto Rico.

Magda's commitment to the community is reflected through her life-long dedication to volunteer work for a variety of service organizations locally and internationally. She was raised in the family of Rotary and, following her father's example, joined the Fayetteville Rotary Club in 1998. Magda served as Centennial Club President (2004-2005), has been District Ambassadorial Chair for 3 years and led a GSE Team to Mexico.

Together with her husband, Rotarian Dave, celebrated their 40th wedding anniversary by traveling to India in 2007 to participate in a National Immunization Day for Polio and a clean water project. In honor of their parent's involvement in Rotary, she and her brother, Rotarian Antonio Grillo-Lopez (San Diego, CA), significantly contributed to the construction of a female domnitory at the Nangarhar University in Jalalabad in an effort to advance women's education in the country. Magda is a Paul Harris Fellow, Benefactor and has received multiple awards for service within her Rotary District 7730. She is the District 7730 Governor for 2010-2011.




Luther Tootle reading the name of Dave Lindsay, the chosen one, next year's president.
