Septic Tanks Should Be Cleaned Every 4-5 Years To Avoid Problems

Curtis Oden, Special Projects Director for the County Health Department, entertained the Rotary Club with anecdotes garnered from his experience as a county environmental and health inspector. Curtis' job requires him to inspect 26 private waste water treatment plants in the county, 207 restaurants, 216 public swimming pools and migrant housing camps. Curtis and his team also grant septic tank permits.

Curtis loves his job and Carteret County. "When I was hired by Mr. Harper, he said it was worth \$5,000 just to live in the county. At first I didn't know what he meant, but after mulling it over I think he was right. I left Carteret County once to study medicine but I missed Carteret County so much I returned at the first opportunity."
