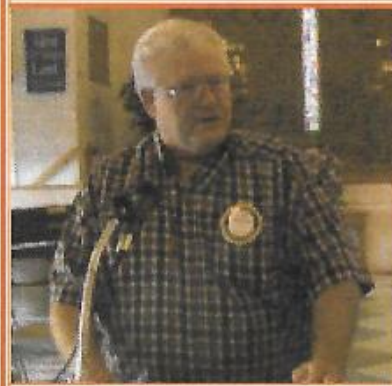

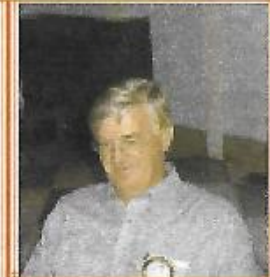

This is to be a great enjoyable social event.

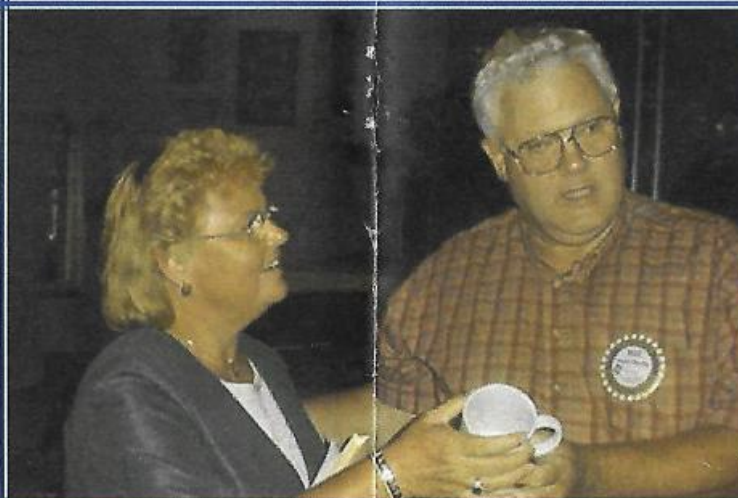
