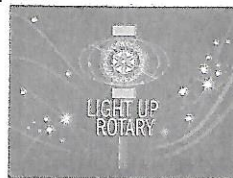

## District Governor Vanessa Ervin Exudes Passion for Rotary

Last week's speaker was District Governor is Vanessa Ervin. Over the past eighteen years, Vanessa's service in Rotary has afforded her the opportunity to serve as Treasurer and then President of the Jacksonville Rotary Club. She has participated in Vocational Service, Club Service, Community Service, Special Projects, International Service, and served as GSE Coordinator. She is currently serving District 7730 as the RI Youth Exchange District Chair.

In her address to the Morehead City Rotary Club, Vanessa said that the Evening Club has a rich legacy stretching back 89 years, beginning with the promotion and establishment of The Morehead City Port Authority followed hundreds of other service projects that benefit the community. For example, the sponsorship of Hospice House, Rotary Park, the playground on Evans Street, and large contributions from individual members to eradicate Polio worldwide are all part of that legacy.

Vanessa asked members why they were Rotarians. Answers ranged from "because I enjoy the club fellowship and the opportunity to make the community a better place to live." to "I like being a member of an organization that has an impact on world problems."

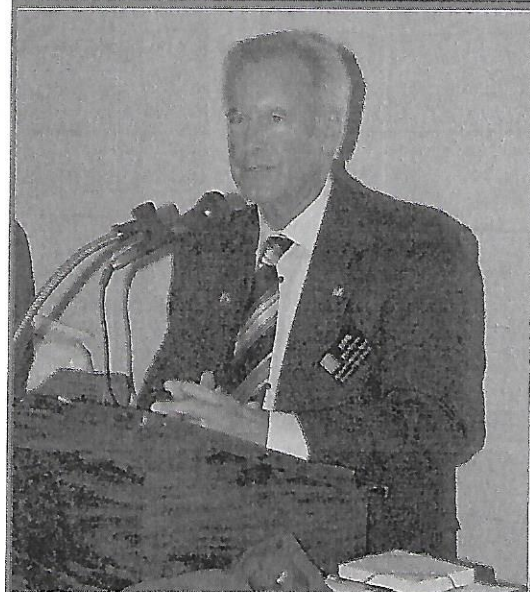
The District Governor concluded her address by telling how the decision to become a Rotarian affected her life in a positive way.

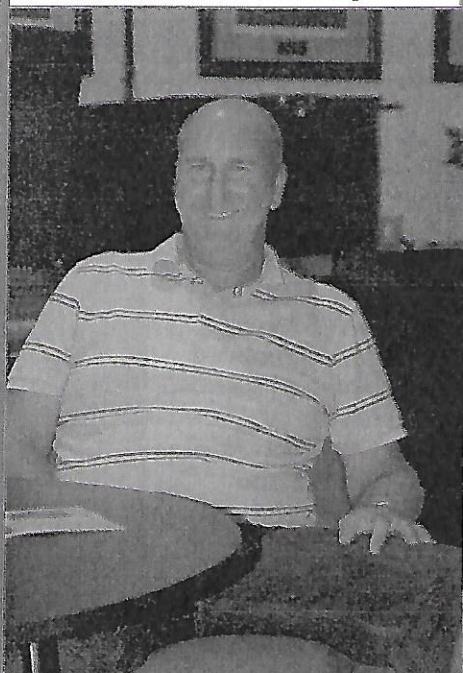

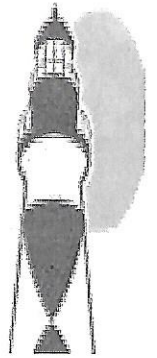

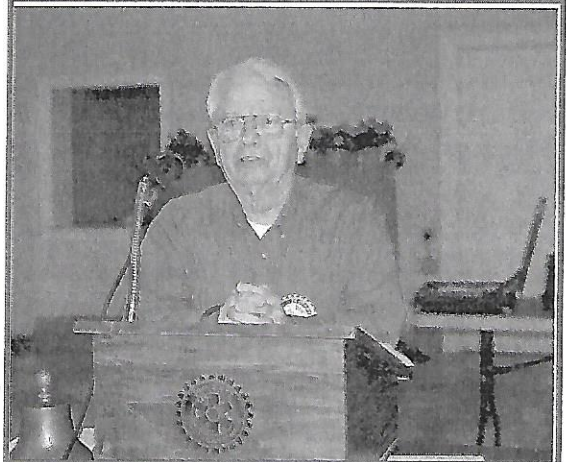
